As Superintendent Campbell messaged earlier this week, San Diego County officially entered the red tier and we are all set to welcome our hybrid students back on campus starting with our Cohort A students on Tuesday, March 23rd. The first day back for Cohort B students will be Wednesday, March 24th. There are undoubtedly many questions regarding how school will be different during hybrid and what our students can expect. Please take some time this weekend to review the following information:

1. The Parent/Guardian Health and Safety Agreement that you completed online covers many of the safety protocols. In addition to having this form completed all students need to have their Lumisight account activated so that they can complete the lumisight screening process online prior to coming to school each day.
